## Note by the Secretariat

- 1. The attention of the Commission is drawn to General Assembly resolution 50/166, entitled "The role of the United Nations Development Fund for Women in eliminating violence against women", which requested, in paragraph 4, "the Fund to include in its regular reports information regarding its activities to eliminate violence against women and girls and to provide such information to the Commission on the Status of Women and the Commission on Human Rights".
- 2. In accordance with the above resolution, the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM) transmitted to the Secretariat a report regarding its activities in eliminating violence against women. The report, contained in document E/CN.6/1996/11, will be made available to the Commission at its fifty-second session.
