## 1996/... Forced evictions

The Commission on Human Rights, taking note of resolution 1995/29 of 24 August 1995 of the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities, bearing in mind the work of other United Nations bodies on this issue, notably that of the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (Habitat), and mindful of the need to avoid unnecessary duplication, decided, at its ... meeting on ... April 1996, to request the Sub-Commission to reconsider, in the light of the conclusions of the United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (Habitat II), to be held in Istanbul in June 1996, its recommendation to convene an expert seminar on the practice of forced evictions with a view to developing comprehensive human rights guidelines on development-based displacement.
