REPORT OF THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The twenty-fifth report of the International Atomic Energy Agency for the calendar year 1980 1/ is submitted herewith to the General Assembly. 2/ Major developments since this report was published will be covered by the annual statement of the Director-General of the Agency to the General Assembly. This report has been transmitted in accordance with the provision of article III, paragraph 1 (a), of the Agreement governing the relationship between the United Nations and the International Atomic Energy Agency. 3/

Regarding the usage in the United Nations, it will be recalled that, by resolution 2758 (XXVI) of 25 October 1971, the General Assembly, inter alia, decided "... to restore all its rights to the People's Republic of China and to recognize the representatives of its Government as the only legitimate representatives of China to the United Nations, and to expel forthwith the representatives of Chiang Kai-shek from the place which they unlawfully occupy at the United Nations and in all the organizations related to it".
