Letter from the Leader of the First of September Revolution, Socialist People's Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, to the Secretary-General

HIS EXCELLENCY
DR. KURT WALDHEIM

EXCELLENCY,

IT IS WITH RECREI THAT I DRAW YOUR EXCELLENCY'S ATTENTION TO A VERY PAINFUL HUMAN TRAGEDY, A TRAGEDY THAT SHOULD HAVE SHOCKED THE CONSCIENCE OF THE ENTIRE WORLD. BUT IT APPEARS THAT THE WORLD IN WHICH WE LIVE HAS LOST ITS CONSCIENCE DUE TO THE MANY VIOLENT SHOCKS IT HAS SUFFERED.

I WOULD LIKE TO DRAW YOUR EXCELLENCY'S ATTENTION TO THE SERIES OF COURAGEOUS, BUT TRAGIC AND GRADUAL DEATH TAKING A TOLL, EVERY SIXTY DAYS, OF SOME OF THE BRAVEST SONS OF NORTHERN IRELAND WHO ARE PAYING WITH THEIR OWN LIVES FOR THE INTRANSIGENT ATTITUDE OF BRITAIN WHICH REFUSES TO GRANT THEM THE STATUS OF POLITICAL PRISONERS. THESE MEN SHOULD BE GRANTED A POLITICAL STATUS IN VIEW OF THE FACT THAT THEY ARE INDEED FIGHTING FOR A JUST AND SACRED CAUSE; THE FREEDOM OF THEIR NATION, WHICH IS ONE OF THE WORLD'S SMALLEST, BUT WHICH STILL HAS ITS PLACE UNDER THE SUN, FREE AS GOD CREATED IT.

EXCELLENCY.

IN SPITE OF THE GOOD RELATIONS EXISTING BETWEEN MY COUNTRY AND BRITAIN, I WISH FOR HUMANITARIAN AND REVOLUTIONARY CONSIDERATIONS AND NOT POLITICAL ONES AS I DO NOT ASSUME ANY POLITICAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE POSITION, TO CALL UPON YOUR EXCELLENCY, AND THROUGH YOU, UPON THE UNITED NATIONS, AND URGE YOU TO INTERVENE IN ORDER TO PUT AN END TO THE SERIES OF TRAGIC DEATHS.

OTHERWISE, THE PRICE THAT WILL BE PAID BY ALL INTRANSIGENT PEOPLE AND FENCESITTERS MAY BE MORE DAMAGING AND PAINFUL.

IF WE CANNOT PUT A HALT TO THIS TRAGEDY, HISTORY, THE FUTURE GENERATIONS AND THE CONSCIENCE OF HUMANITY, WHEN RE-AWAKENED, WILL CURSE THE

THE CIVILIZATION OF OUR TIMES AND LOOK ON THIS ERA AS A RELAPSE TO THE HATEFUL DARK AGES, EVEN SURPASSING THEM IN DISCRIMINATION AND DEGENERATION. EXCELLENCY.

'I LOUDLY AND STRONGLY CONDEMN THE INHUMAN ATTITUDE OF THE BRITISH AND THE FEEBLE STANCE OF THE WORLD TOWARD THIS HUMAN CAUSE, REGARDLESS OF ITS POLITICAL ASPECT, WHICH IS EQUALLY JUST.

I BELIEVE THAT MY VOICE EXPRESSES THE OPINIONS AND SENTIMENTS OF MILLIONS OF PEOPLE WHOSE VOICES CANNOT BE HEARD.

THUS, I PUT ON RECORD FOR THE FUTURE GENERATIONS A DOCUMENT OF THE UNITED NATIONS THAT WILL SPARE MY COUNTRY AND MYSELF THE CONDEMNATION OF HISTORY, AND WHICH ALSO CONSTITUTES A DOCUMENT IN DEFENSE OF A GROUP OF HUMAN BEINGS DRIVEN TO THEIR DEATH AT AN AVERAGE OF ONE PERSON EVERY SIXTY DAYS, A CASE REMINISCENT OF THOSE SAD AND TERRIFYING HUMAN OFFERINGS IN THE AGES LONG PAST, WITHOUT ANY PROTEST FROM THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD.

PLEASE ACCEPT, EXCELLENCY, THE ASSURANCES OF MY HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.
