- 1. At its 2nd meeting, on 21 September 1981, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/36/161/Add.1) concerning the vacancy that had arisen on the Advisory Committee for Administrative and Budgetary Questions as a result of the resignation of Mr. George F. Saddler.
- 2. Mrs. Virginia Housholder (United States of America) was nominated by her Government to fill the vacancy in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for the unexpired portion of Mr. Saddler's appointment, until 31 December 1981 (A/C.5/36/5).
- 3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should appoint Mrs. Virginia Housholder (United States of America) as a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions for a term of office beginning on \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_1981 1/2 and ending on 31 December 1981.
