REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Transport and Communications Decade in Africa

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, in its resolution 35/108 on the Transport and Communications Decade in Africa, inter alia requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Economic and Social Council, at its second regular session of 1981, a progress report on the implementation of the programme for the Decade. That progress report, which was considered by the Economic and Social Council at its second regular session of 1981, is now before the General Assembly (A/36/342).
2. At its second regular session, the Economic and Social Council adopted resolution 1981/67 of 24 July 1981, in which it requested the Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Africa to make the report of the technical consultative meeting, to be held at Yaoundé in September 1981, available to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session.
3. The Secretary-General has been informed that the technical consultative meeting has been postponed from September 1981 to March 1982. The Executive Secretary of the Economic Commission for Africa is carrying out further consultations with donors to ensure the success of the meeting. It is anticipated that the report on the meeting will be available for submission to the General Assembly at its thirty-seventh session through the Economic and Social Council.
