Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Secretary-General has been informed of the resignation from membership in the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions of Mr. Rudolph Schmidt (Federal Republic of Germany). Graduated from Faculty of Law, Saarbrücken University, in 1969.

1969-72, preparatory legal service.

1972, entered the Regional Finance Directorate, Saarbrücken, where he was concerned with customs and excise.

1974-81, Federal Ministry of Finance, Bonn.

Served in divisions concerned with international financial and monetary questions, in particular the EEC budget, and investigations of irregularities in the European agricultural market.

Since September 1981, seconded to the Permanent Mission of the Federal Republic of Germany to the United Nations. Delegate of the Federal Republic of Germany on the Fifth Committee.

Representative of the Federal Republic of Germany on the Committee on Conferences.
