QUESTION OF NAMIBIA

Letter dated 24 May 1979 from the Permanent Representative  
of Viet Nam to the United Nations addressed to the President  
of the General Assembly and to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to express to you that the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam fully supports the message dated 18 May 1979 sent to you by His Excellency Mr. Hun Sen, Minister for Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of Kampuchea (A/33/566, annex).

Undoubtedly, those who are proclaiming themselves as representatives of "Democratic Kampuchea" were driven out of their country by the Kampuchean people themselves and have no right to be present at this resumed session of the General Assembly.

I request you to have this letter circulated as an official document of the General Assembly under agenda item 27.
