## RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

PROGRAMME OF ACTION FOR THE ELIMINATION OF THE EXPLOITATION OF CHILD LABOUR

## Note by the Secretariat

- 1. In its resolution 1993/79, the Commission on Human Rights adopted the Programme of Action for the Elimination of the Exploitation of Child Labour. It also requested the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities to submit every two years a report to the Commission on Human Rights on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action by all States.
- 2. In its resolution 1995/16, the Sub-Commission on Prevention of Discrimination and Protection of Minorities requested the Secretary-General to invite States to inform the Working Group on Contemporary Forms of Slavery of measures adopted to implement the Programme of Action.
- 3. The Sub-Commission also requested the Secretary-General to submit a report on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action to the Sub-Commission at its forty-eighth session and to the Commission at its fifty-third session. Pursuant to that request, the attention of the Commission is drawn to the report of the Secretary-General to the Sub-Commission on the state of implementation of the Programme of Action (E/CN.4/Sub.2/1996/25) and Add.1), which is being made available to the Commission at its present session.
