RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE RIGHTS OF THE CHILD

Report of the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, in its resolution 44/25 of 20 November 1989, adopted the Convention on the Rights of the Child and expressed the hope that it would come into force at an early date. The Convention was opened for signature in New York on 26 January 1990 and, in accordance with article 49 thereof, entered into force on 2 September 1990, on the thirtieth day after the date of the deposit with the Secretary-General of the United Nations of the twentieth instrument of ratification or accession.
- In its resolution 1996/85 I of 24 April 1996, the Commission on Human Rights urged once again all States that had not done so to sign, and ratify or accede to the Convention as a matter of priority; urged States parties that had made reservations to review the compatibility of their reservations with article 51 of the Convention and other relevant rules of international law; and took note with appreciation of the constructive role of the Committee on the Rights of the Child in creating awareness of the principles and provisions of the Convention and in providing recommendations to States parties on its implementation. In resolution 1996/85 II the Commission noted the progress made in the working group on a draft optional protocol to the Convention on the Rights of the Child on the involvement of children in armed conflicts; invited the Committee on the Rights of the Child to offer comments on the draft optional protocol and consider being represented at future sessions of the working group; requested the working group to meet for a period of two weeks prior to the fifty-third session of the Commission; invited Member States and United Nations bodies and organs, as well as other relevant organizations, to contribute to the ongoing study by the expert designated by the Secretary-General on the impact of armed conflicts on children; and

welcomed financial contributions made to the voluntary trust fund established by the Secretary-General to finance information and training programmes relating to mine clearance. The Commission, in resolution 1996/85 III, welcomed the report of the Special Rapporteur on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography, appealed to all Governments to cooperate with and assist the Special Rapporteur and noted the progress made in the working group on a draft optional protocol to the Convention on the Rights of the Child on the sale of children, child prostitution and child pornography and invited the Committee to offer comments on the draft optional protocol and to consider being represented at future sessions. In resolution 1996/85 V the Commission requested the Secretary-General to submit to the Commission at its fifty-third session a report on the status of the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

- 3. As at 1 November 1996 the Convention had received 138 signatures which were followed by ratification. In addition, 43 States had acceded to the Convention and 6 had succeeded to it, bringing the total of ratification and accessions to the Convention to 187. A list of States that have ratified or acceded to the Convention, and the dates of their signature, ratification or accession, appears in the annex to the present report.
- 4. The Committee on the Rights of the Child held its eleventh session from 8 to 26 January 1996 at the United Nations Office at Geneva. At that session the Committee considered reports submitted by seven States parties to the Convention. In addition, the Committee reviewed its cooperation with United Nations bodies in connection with the consideration of two draft optional protocols to the Convention. The Committee adopted a report on its eleventh session (CRC/C/50) as well as its biennial report to the General Assembly (A/51/41).
- 5. The Committee on the Rights of the Child held its twelfth session from 20 May to 7 June 1996 at the United Nations Office at Geneva. During that session, the Committee considered reports submitted by six States parties to the Convention. The Committee decided to contribute actively to the second United Nations Conference on Human Settlements (Habitat II). The Committee was represented at a meeting organized by the International Labour Organization on the prevention and elimination of child labour which took place on 12 June 1996. The Committee adopted a report on its twelfth session (CRC/C/54).
- 6. The Committee on the Rights of the Child held its thirteenth session at the United Nations Office at Geneva from 23 September to 11 October 1996. During that session the Committee considered six States parties reports submitted under the Convention. One day was devoted to a general discussion on the topic "The child and the media". The Committee identified three main areas for discussion: to develop the possibility for children to participate actively in the media; to enhance the protection of children against harmful influence through the media; to encourage the media to improve the children's image through their reporting. The Committee also adopted at that session its guidelines regarding the form and contents of periodic reports from States parties (CRC/C/58). The Committee adopted the report of the thirteenth session (CRC/C/57).
- 7. The fourteenth session of the Committee on the Rights of the Child will be held from 6 to 24 January 1997 in Geneva.

- 8. The Conference of the States parties held in accordance with article 50 of the Convention on 12 December 1995 decided to amend article 43, paragraph 2, of the Convention, in order to increase the membership of the Committee from 10 to 18 experts. The amendment, approved by the General Assembly on 21 December 1995, is to enter into force after acceptance by a two-thirds majority of States parties.
- 9. The Sixth Meeting of the States parties to elect five members of the Committee to replace those members whose mandate expires on 28 February 1997 is scheduled to take place on 18 February 1997 at Headquarters.
