619. At the same meeting, the Chairman introduced a proposal for restructuring the Commission's agenda. The proposal was contained in document E/CN.4/1996/L.100 and read as follows:

Proposal by the Chairman: Restructuring of the Commission's agenda

1. The present document, circulated at the request of the Chairman of the fifty-second session of the Commission on Human Rights, sets out in tabular form the results of the Chairman's wide informal consultations with all regional groups on the possible restructuring of the Commission's future agendas, including the draft provisional agenda for the Commission's fifty-third session. 2. Annex I contains the titles of the proposed items in the restructured agenda. For orientation, and to facilitate understanding of the Chairman's proposal, annex II sets out a comparison between the restructured agenda and the agenda of the fifty-first session, with an indication of how the resolutions adopted at the fifty-first session would correspond to the restructured agenda.

3. Should the Chairman's proposal, as set out in annex I, meet with the approval of the Commission, the draft provisional agenda for the fifty-third session, prepared by the Secretary-General in accordance with paragraph 3 of Economic and Social Council resolution 1894 (LVII) and issued in document E/CN.4/1996/L.1, would be adapted accordingly for inclusion in the report of the Commission to the Council on the work of its fifty-second session.

4. A list of a number of other issues of possible reform, requiring further consultations, will be issued separately in document E/CN.4/1996/CRP.1.
