# Item 3 - Review of the progress in the development of transit systems and proposals for future action

- 3. Pursuant to paragraph 11 of General Assembly resolution 50/97, the Meeting is to review progress in the development of transit systems in the land-locked and transit developing countries with a view to exploring the possibility of formulating specific action-oriented measures. This review will take into account the results of consultations between individual land-locked countries and their transit neighbours, which will be organized as part of the intergovernmental meeting.
- 4. For the consideration of this item, the Meeting will have before it a report prepared by the UNCTAD secretariat. The report is in three sections. The first section provides an overall perspective of how transit transport constraints have affected the economic environment in the land-locked developing countries, particularly with regard to the trade patterns of these countries. The second section then reviews the recent actions at the national, subregional and international level to improve the transit systems in the different key areas, including the specific problems that have been encountered. The third section elaborates the proposed main elements of a future programme of action.
