STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Bangladesh, Egypt, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of)\*, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya\*, Malaysia, Nigeria\*, Papua New Guinea\*, Republic of Korea, Saudi Arabia\*, Singapore\*, Thailand\*, and United Arab Emirates\*: proposed amendments to draft resolution E/CN.4/1997/L.20

1. <u>Replace</u> the sixth preambular paragraph <u>by</u>

<u>Recalling</u> that article 6.2 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights provides that sentence of death may be imposed only for the most serious crimes in accordance with the law in force at the time of the commission of the crime and not contrary to the provisions of that Covenant.
