STATUS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANTS ON HUMAN RIGHTS

Bangladesh, Egypt, Indonesia, Iran (Islamic Republic of)*, Libyan Arab Jamahiriya*, Malaysia, Nigeria*, Papua New Guinea*, Republic of Korea, Saudi Arabia*, Singapore*, Thailand*, and United Arab Emirates*: proposed amendments to draft resolution E/CN.4/1997/L.20

1. Replace the sixth preambular paragraph by

Recalling that article 6.2 of the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights provides that sentence of death may be imposed only for the most serious crimes in accordance with the law in force at the time of the commission of the crime and not contrary to the provisions of that Covenant.

2. Add the following operative paragraph 1
Reaffirms the sovereign right of States to determine the legal system appropriate to their societies, taking into account the relevant provisions of international law;
