Letter dated 15 July 1997 from the Secretary-General to the President of the General Assembly

Further to my letter dated 24 April 1997 (A/ES-10/3), I have the honour to inform you that Cape Verde, the Dominican Republic, Georgia, Guinea, Guinea-Bissau, Madagascar, Nicaragua, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Seychelles and Vanuatu1 have made the necessary payments to reduce their arrears below the amount specified in Article 19 of the Charter.
