NOTE VERBALE DATED 12 NOVEMBER 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT  
REPRESENTATIVE OF ITALY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED  
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Italy presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to paragraph 24 of Security Council resolution 864 (1993), has the honour to provide the following information.

The Italian Government, by decree No. 440 of 8 November 1993, adopted the regulation approved on 25 October 1993 by the Council of Ministers of the European Communities to enforce the embargo on the National Union for the Total Independence of Angola (UNITA) decided by Security Council resolution 864 (1993).

The decree establishes in paragraph 2 that transactions which violate this regulation are null and void. Furthermore, in the same paragraph 2, the decree imposes an administrative sanction, consisting of the payment of an amount of money no less than half the value of a transaction and not higher than the transaction, on those who commit infractions of the above regulation.
