LETTER DATED 30 AUGUST 1997 FROM THE CHARGE D'AFFAIRES A.I. OF THE PERMANENT MISSION OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, I have the honour to inform you that 151 unexploded bombs, missiles and other ordnance left behind by the 30-Power aggression against Iraq were found and disposed of in various parts of Iraqi territory between 1 June and 31 July 1997. They included American-made cluster bombs, as well as fragmentation bombs, strip bombs and spindle bombs, and were found in the governorates of Ninawa, Basra, Ta'mim and Anbar.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
