SUMMARY

The present addendum provides detailed financial information on contributions to and expenditure from UNDP account and other programmes. It also provides, in accordance with Governing Council decision 84/9 of 29 June 1987, information on the net flow of contributions to and payments from the United Nations Development Programme system in respect of each participating Government. Information is also provided on the shortfall of contributions to local office costs after application of the accounting linkage, as authorized in Governing Council decision 84/9. Separate statements of income and expenditure, and of assets and liabilities, for the Reserve for Field Accommodation are also included in this report. The Executive Board may wish to take note of the present addendum.
