Item 3: Possible trade and investment impacts of environmental management standards, particularly the ISO 14000 series, on developing countries, and opportunities and needs in this context

The Meeting is convened pursuant to a decision by the Commission on Trade in Goods and Services, and Commodities at the second part of its first session (19-21 February 1997). The objective is to "examine the operation, and the possible trade and investment impacts, of environmental management standards, particularly the ISO 14000 series, on developing countries, and the identification of possible opportunities and needs in this context".¹

With a view to expediting substantive discussions of the Expert Meeting, the secretariat has prepared an issues paper entitled "Environmental management standards, particularly the ISO 14000 series: trade and investment impacts on developing countries" (TD/B/COM.1/EM.4/2).

The Expert Meeting is intended to enhance understanding of the issue under discussion, identify relevant factors determining the trade and investment effects of environmental management standards, in particular ISO 14001, on developing countries, and elucidate the types of policy choices that Governments and the business sector in developing countries are facing, or will be facing, in the context of environmental management standards, in particular in relation to issues in the field of international trade. The Expert Meeting could draw lessons from country-specific experiences.

In addition to an introductory session dealing with the operation of environmental management standards, the Expert Meeting could discuss four issues, as follows: (i) environmental management standards: possible trade and investment effects; (ii) certification and accreditation issues; (iii) needs of small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs); (iv) needs of developing countries.

The results of the Expert Meeting will be submitted to the Commission on Trade in Goods and Services, and Commodities, at its second session (17-21 November 1997) for action.
