NOTE VERBALE DATED 10 APRIL 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF MALAYSIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Malaysia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to the latter's note No. PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977, has the honour to inform him that Malaysia has consistently and vigorously opposed the oppressive and inhuman nature of the apartheid system of South Africa. In accordance with this policy, the Government of Malaysia has no relations whatsoever, diplomatic, economic or otherwise with the racist Government. Malaysia has also never traded arms with South Africa; nor has it the intention to do so in future. Malaysia thus pledges its full support to the implementation of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) and will strictly comply with its provisions.

The Permanent Representative of Malaysia has the honour to request that this communication be issued as a document of the Security Council.
