REPORT OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE WORK OF THE ORGANIZATION

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. By its resolution 49/143 of 23 December 1994, the General Assembly decided to establish a high-level open-ended working group, under the chairmanship of the President of the General Assembly and with two vice-chairmen, to consider additional measures aimed at ensuring a sound and viable financial basis for the Organization. By its decision 50/488 of 16 September 1996, the Assembly decided that the Working Group should submit to it at its fifty-first session, through the Fifth Committee, a report on its work including any possible recommendations.
- 2. At its 72nd meeting, on 8 September 1997, the Fifth Committee considered the report of the High-level Open-ended Working Group on the Financial Situation of the United Nations. Statements and observations made in the course of the Committee's consideration of the report are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/51/SR.72).
- 3. At the same meeting, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Committee, without objection, took note of the report of the High-level Open-ended Working Group on the Financial Situation of the United Nations and decided to transmit it to the General Assembly at its resumed fifty-first session, for action.
