NOTE VERBALE DATED 11 AUGUST 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION OF
LATVIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Latvia to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, with reference to note SCA/10/97/(1) dated 11 April 1997 from the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 748 (1992) concerning the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya, has the honour to report the following:

- Libya has no diplomatic consular representation in the Republic of Latvia and the Republic of Latvia has no diplomatic or consular representation in Libya. Consequently, there was no need for any action to be taken by the Government of the Republic of Latvia for the implementation of paragraph 6 (a) of the resolution;
- As regards paragraph 4 (a) of the above-mentioned resolution, the Republic of Latvia will deny permission to any aircraft to take off from, land in or overfly its territory if it is destined to land in or has taken off from the territory of Libya, unless the particular flight has been approved on grounds of significant humanitarian need by the Committee established by paragraph 9 of the resolution.
