NOTE VERBALE DATED 25 MAY 1978 FROM THE ACTING PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE PHILIPPINES TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Acting Permanent Representative of the Philippines to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his note PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) dated 18 May 1978 concerning Security Council resolution 418 (1977) on the question of South Africa.

The Philippines does not maintain diplomatic, economic, cultural, trade or any form of relations with South Africa and has, with strict consistency, supported, adhered to, and observed all resolutions of the United Nations on the question of South Africa. Recognition or co-operation in whatever manner is not accorded by the Philippine Government to the apartheid régime of South Africa.
