NOTE VERBALE DATED 5 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Iran to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to his notes PO 230 SOAF dated 3 April 1978, PO 230 SOAF (2-2-4) and PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) dated 18 May 1978 regarding information sought by the Security Council Committee established by resolution 421 (1977) concerning the question of South Africa.

In this connexion, the Permanent Representative of Iran wishes to reiterate the contents of the reply of the Government of Iran to the Secretary-General's note PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977 contained in his note dated 9 March 1978 (S/12596) to the effect that: "While stating that Iran has never engaged in arms transactions with South Africa and that it will never involve itself in such transactions in the future, the Government of Iran hereby announces its full support for all measures recommended in the aforementioned resolutions and once again reiterates that it will scrupulously adhere to their provisions".
