NOTE VERBALE DATED 9 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SYRIAN ARAB REPUBLIC TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Syrian Arab Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to His Excellency's notes PO 230 SOAF, PO 230 SOAF (2-2-4), PO 230 SOAF (2-2-5) dated 3 April 1978, 18 May 1978, and 18 May 1978 respectively, has the honour to inform him that the Syrian Arab Republic had already made known its position on the question of South Africa as expressed in its note S/12682 dated 27 April 1978, stating that the Syrian Government has consistently opposed the apartheid system and has never had any relations of any kind with the racist regime of South Africa. Syria has always expressed its unequivocal support for the people of South Africa in their just struggle to put an end to the apartheid regime and for liberation and national independence. The Syrian Arab Republic pledges furthermore its support and co-operation with the Security Council Committee established under resolution 421 (1977) concerning the question of South Africa.
