NOTE VERBALE DATED 14 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT MISSION
OF MAURITIUS TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE
SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Mission of Mauritius to the United Nations presents its compliments to His Excellency, the Secretary-General of the United Nations and with reference to his note PO 230 SOAF of 10 November 1977, concerning the implementation of resolution 418 (1977) on the question of South Africa has the honour to communicate the following information received in a letter from the Ministry of External Affairs of Mauritius:

"The provisions of Security Council resolution 418 (1977) have been fully implemented by the Government. Mauritius does not have any arms dealings with South Africa.

"Furthermore, we have raised our voice in several regional and international forums against the apartheid policy of the South African Government and shall continue to do so."

The Permanent Mission of Mauritius has the honour to request that this note verbale be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
