LETTER DATED 14 JUNE 1978 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF VENEZUELA
TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

I take pleasure in addressing you with reference to paragraph 3 of resolution 418 (1977) in response to the request of the Security Council Committee established under resolution 421 (1977), relating to the question of South Africa.

The Mission of which I am in charge confirms its note of 26 January 1978 (S/12541) in which it stated that Venezuela has not maintained, and will not maintain, relations of any kind with the racist régime of South Africa and will continue to comply with all the decisions taken by the United Nations against that régime. Therefore, it does not have to review any contract or licence relating to the manufacture of military equipment, as mentioned in paragraph 3.

I should be grateful if this note could be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
