1. After paragraph 517, insert the following new paragraph 518:

518. The representative of Bangladesh, referring to paragraphs 80 and 101 of chapter III above, emphasized that a UNEP mission had established incontrovertibly that the water flow in his country's rivers in the dry season had been drastically reduced, and that pockets of desert were mushrooming in various places. His Government had committed itself to amicable negotiations with its neighbour in order to resolve the dispute which had arisen; at the same time, it was seeking the assistance of UNEP in dealing with the consequences of the problem, and it was difficult to see why any other country should object to such assistance being granted.
