Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Mario MARTORELL (Peru)

1. At its 20th meeting, on 23 October 1981, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/36/163) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1982.
2. The Auditor-General of Ghana was nominated by his Government for reappointment to fill the vacancy arising on the United Nations Board of Auditors (A/C.5/36/21).
3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to recommend the Auditor-General of Ghana for reappointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1982.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the Auditor-General of Ghana as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1982.
