Confirmation of the appointment of three members
of the Investments Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 20th meeting, on 23 October 1981, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/36/164) concerning the vacancies arising on the Investments Committee as a result of the expiration of the terms of office, on 31 December 1981, of three of its members. The Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/20), in which, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General recommended for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Mr. Jean Guyot (France), and Mr. George Johnston (United States of America) and the appointment of Mr. Michiya Matsukawa (Japan), for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1982.

2. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should confirm the appointments of Mr. Jean Guyot, Mr. George Johnston and Mr. Michiya Matsukawa for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1982.
