1. Since the issuance of documents A/52/388 and Add.1, additional information has been received from the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.

United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland

2. In a note verbale dated 10 October 1997, the Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations provided additional information to the Secretary-General that during the financial year 1996/1997 the United Kingdom has offered a total of 51 scholarships to students from its Non-Self-Governing Territories, as follows: Anguilla (2); Bermuda (21); British Virgin Islands (1); Cayman Islands (12); Montserrat (3); Saint Helena (11); and Turks and Caicos Islands (1).
