## Relationship between disarmament and development

The General Assembly,

<u>Recalling</u> the provisions of the Final Document of the Tenth Special Session of the General Assembly<sup>1</sup> concerning the relationship between disarmament and development,

<u>Recalling also</u> the adoption on 11 September 1987 of the Final Document of the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development,<sup>2</sup>

Recalling further its resolutions 49/75 J of 15 December 1994, 50/70 G of 12 December 1995 and 51/45 D of 10 December 1996,

<u>Bearing in mind</u> the Final Document of the Eleventh Conference of Heads of State or Government of the Non-Aligned Countries, held at Cartagena de Indias, Colombia, from 18 to 20 October 1995,<sup>3</sup>

<u>Stressing</u> the growing importance of the symbiotic relationship between disarmament and development in current international relations,

1. <u>Acknowledges</u> the note by the Secretary-General<sup>4</sup> and actions taken in accordance with the Final Document of the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development;<sup>2</sup>

2. <u>Urges</u> the international community to devote part of the resources made available by the implementation of disarmament and arms limitation agreements to economic and social development, with a view to reducing the ever widening gap between developed and developing countries;

3. <u>Invites</u> all Member States to communicate to the Secretary-General, by 15 April 1998, their views and proposals for the implementation of the action programme adopted at the International Conference on the Relationship between Disarmament and Development,<sup>5</sup> as well as any other views and proposals with a view to achieving the goals of the action programme, within the framework of current international relations;

4. <u>Requests</u> the Secretary-General to continue to take action, through appropriate organs and within available resources, for the implementation of the action programme adopted at the International Conference;

5. <u>Also requests</u> the Secretary-General to submit a report to the General Assembly at its fifty-third session;

6. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-third session the item entitled "Relationship between disarmament and development".
