Anti-personnel landmines

The General Assembly,

<u>Recalling</u> its previous resolutions 48/75 K of 16 December 1993, 49/75 D of 15 December 1994, 50/70 O of 12 December 1995 and 51/45 S of 10 December 1996,

<u>Taking into account</u> the efforts to address the landmine issue, and underlining that the efforts made within different forums should be mutually reinforcing,

<u>Taking note</u> of the decisions taken by States to adopt bans, moratoriums or other restrictions on transfers of anti-personnel landmines and other measures taken unilaterally,

Having considered the report of the Conference on Disarmament,¹

1. <u>Urges</u> all States to intensify their efforts to contribute to the objective of the elimination of anti-personnel landmines;

2. <u>Welcomes</u> the various bans, moratoriums and other restrictions already declared by States on anti-personnel landmines, and calls upon States that have not yet done so to declare and implement such bans, moratoriums and other restrictions as soon as possible;

3. <u>Invites</u> the Conference on Disarmament to intensify its efforts on the issue of anti-personnel landmines;

4. <u>Decides</u> to include in the provisional agenda of its fifty-third session an item entitled "Contributions toward banning anti-personnel landmines".
