Appointment of an alternate member of the United Nations  
Staff Pension Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 20th meeting, on 23 October 1981, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/36/14) concerning the vacancy that had arisen on the United Nations Staff Pension Committee as a result of the resignation of Mr. Rudolf Schmidt, as an alternate member of that Committee.
2. Mr. Jobst Holborn (Federal Republic of Germany) was nominated by his Government to fill the vacancy as an alternate member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for the unexpired portion of Mr. Schmidt's appointment, until 31 December 1982.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by acclamation, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should appoint Mr. Jobst Holborn (Federal Republic of Germany) as an alternate member of the United Nations Staff Pension Committee for a term of office beginning on \_\_\_\_\_ 1981 1/ and ending on 31 December 1982.
