APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS: APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. As indicated in document A/52/103 of 13 June 1997, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to appoint the Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) of a Member State to fill the vacancy that will arise in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors, effective 30 June 1998.
- 2. The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has nominated the Comptroller and Auditor-General of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for reappointment to the United Nations Board of Auditors for a term of office beginning on 1 July 1998 and ending on 30 June 2001.
