APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS
AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS: APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF
THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

Note by the Secretary-General

1. As indicated in document A/52/103 of 13 June 1997, it will be necessary for the General Assembly, during its current session, to appoint the Auditor-General (or officer holding the equivalent title) of a Member State to fill the vacancy that will arise in the membership of the United Nations Board of Auditors, effective 30 June 1998.
2. The Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland has nominated the Comptroller and Auditor-General of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland for reappointment to the United Nations Board of Auditors for a term of office beginning on 1 July 1998 and ending on 30 June 2001.
