I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 19 September 1997, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its fifty-second session the item entitled:

"Macroeconomic policy questions:

- "(a) Financing of development, including net transfer of resources between developing and developed countries;
- "(b) Trade and development;
- "(c) Science and technology for development;
- "(d) External debt crisis and development"

and to allocate it to the Second Committee.

2. The Second Committee considered the item at its 9th to 11th, 34th, 35th and 41st meetings, on 16 and 17 October and 10 and 13 November 1997.
