SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 864 (1993) CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN ANGOLA

NOTE VERBALE DATED 1 DECEMBER 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Representative of the Czech Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola and with reference to the latter's notes dated 16 September 1997 and 4 November 1997 referring to Security Council resolution 1127 (1997) of 28 August 1997, has the honour to inform him, in accordance with paragraph 8 of the resolution, of the steps taken by the Government of the Czech Republic to give effect to the provisions set out in paragraph 4 of the resolution.

The Government of the Czech Republic has decided to suspend the granting of visas to senior officials of the União Nacional para a Independência Total de Angola and adult members of their immediate families. The decision will be implemented without delay as soon as the list of the above persons has been drawn up and distributed.

As to the implementation of the other provisions encompassed in paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997), it will probably necessitate the adoption of relevant law by the Parliament of the Czech Republic. To this end, the consultations are currently being held within the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Czech Republic.
