SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED
PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 864 (1993)
CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN ANGOLA

LETTER DATED 28 NOVEMBER 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF FRANCE TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF
THE COMMITTEE

In accordance with paragraph 8 of resolution 1135 (1997) of
29 October 1997 and in reply to your letter of 4 November on this subject, I
would like to inform you of the measures taken by France to implement
paragraph 4 of resolution 1127 (1997) of 28 August 1997.

The "Demain l'Angola" Association, which constituted the de facto
representation of the União Nacional para a Independência Total de Angola
(UNITA) in France, has been dissolved. The relevant memorandum of dissolution
was sent to the Paris Préfecture de police, which has acknowledged its receipt.
The dissolution order is therefore in force and a notice to this effect will be
published in the Journal officiel. The spokesman for the Ministry of Foreign
Affairs made this information public on 25 November.

In addition, measures concerning air links with the areas held by UNITA
have been dealt with in a regulation of the European Community, which adopted a
common position on the matter on 31 October.

Measures relating to the UNITA leaders will be implemented as soon as the
Sanctions Committee draws up a list of the persons concerned.
