PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF BRAZIL TO THE
UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN
OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Representative of Brazil to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola and has the honour, with reference to paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 1135 (1997), to inform him that the Brazilian authorities have been taking all necessary actions to enforce the measures set out in paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997), which entered into force pursuant to resolution 1135 (1997).

In this connection, it should be mentioned that the União Nacional para a Independência Total de Angola (UNITA) has no office in Brazil. With regard to the measures mentioned in subparagraphs 4 (a) and 4 (b) of resolution 1127 (1997), they will be enforced upon receipt of a list of UNITA senior officials and of members of their immediate families. The same point applies to subparagraph 4 (a), for which a list of types of aircraft registered in Angola is needed to enforce the measures.
