SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 864 (1993) CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN ANGOLA

LETTER DATED 12 DECEMBER 1997 FROM THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

As a supplement to its response of 3 December 1997 (S/AC.31/1997/11) to the request in paragraph 8 of Security Council resolution 1135 (1997), the United States of America informs the Committee created pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) that the President of the United States on 12 December 1997 signed the following documents establishing measures to implement the provisions of paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997) in accordance with the laws of the United States;

- (a) A Presidential Executive Order requiring the immediate and complete closure of all UNITA offices in United States territory and prohibiting the provision of aircraft or aircraft supplies or services to UNITA by United States persons or from United States territory;
- (b) A Presidential Proclamation preventing the entry into or transit through United States territory of senior UNITA officials and their adult family members, other than those excepted by paragraph 4 (a) of the resolution.
