SECURITY COUNCIL COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED

CONCERNING THE SITUATION IN ANGOLA

NOTE VERBALE DATED 8 DECEMBER 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT
MISSION OF GERMANY TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO
THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Mission of Germany to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) and has the honour to refer to the latter's note dated 4 November 1997. In reply to that note and with reference to resolution 1127 (1997), adopted by the Security Council on 28 August 1997, and to Council resolution 1135 (1997), adopted on 29 October 1997, the Permanent Mission of Germany has the honour to report, in accordance with paragraph 8 of resolution 1135 (1997), the following steps taken by the Federal Republic of Germany in order to give effect to the provisions set out in paragraph 4 of resolution 1127 (1997):

(a) With reference to paragraph 4 (a) and (b) of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997) (travel and residence restrictions)

The restrictions will be implemented without delay as soon as the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) presents a list of persons affected by these restrictions.

(b) With reference to paragraph 4 (c) of resolution 1127 (1997) (closure of UNITA offices)

The Government of the Federal Republic of Germany informed the director of the UNITA office in Bonn in writing on 11 November 1997 of the adoption of resolutions 1127 (1997) and 1135 (1997) by the Security Council and the sanction measures contained therein and requested him to discontinue his representation of UNITA.

(c) With reference to paragraph 4 (d) of resolution 1127 (1997) (air travel restrictions)

The restrictions will be implemented as soon as the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) presents the pertinent lists referred to in paragraph 4 (d) (i) and (iii) of the resolution.
