NOTE VERBALE DATED 17 DECEMBER 1997 FROM THE PERMANENT OBSERVER OF SWITZERLAND TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE

The Permanent Observer of Switzerland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Chairman of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 864 (1993) concerning the situation in Angola, and, with respect to his note verbale dated 4 November 1997, has the honour to inform him that Switzerland intends to apply, on an autonomous basis, the measures referred to in paragraph 4 of Security Council resolution 1127 (1997) of 28 August 1997.

To that end, the Swiss authorities look forward to receiving from the Committee the list of senior UNITA officials and adult members of their immediate families, as well as the list of the various aircraft registered in Angola, referred to in paragraphs 9 and 11 of the new set of guidelines. Moreover, the Permanent Observer of Switzerland would like to inform the Chairman of the Committee that UNITA has no offices in Switzerland.
