SUMMARY STATEMENT BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON MATTERS OF WHICH THE SECURITY COUNCIL IS SEIZED AND ON THE STAGE REACHED IN THEIR CONSIDERATION

## <u>Addendum</u>

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The Security Council resumed its consideration of the item at its 3818th meeting, held on 18 September 1997, in accordance with the understanding reached in its prior consultations.

The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representatives of Croatia and Germany, at their request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
