LETTER DATED 8 JANUARY 1998 FROM THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to refer to Security Council resolution 1145 (1997), of 19 December 1997, in which the Council decided to establish, with effect from 16 January 1998, a support group of 180 civilian police monitors, for a single period of up to nine months to continue to monitor the performance of the Croatian police in the Danube region of the Republic of Croatia.

Following the usual consultations, I should like to inform you that I intend to appoint Mr. Souren Saraydarian (Syrian Arab Republic) as my representative and head of the support group and the United Nations Liaison Office in Zagreb.

I should be grateful if you would bring the foregoing to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
