APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS
AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

CONFIRMATION OF THE APPOINTMENT OF THREE MEMBERS
OF THE INVESTMENTS COMMITTEE

Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General, after consultation with the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary questions, submits for confirmation by the General Assembly the following appointments as members of the United Nations Investments Committee:

For three-year terms, from 1 January 1982

Mr. Jean Guyot (reappointment)
Mr. George Johnston (reappointment)
Mr. Michiya Matsukawa

2. Mr. Guyot was first appointed to the Committee in 1972 for a three-year term commencing in 1973 and Mr. Johnston was first appointed to the Committee for a one-year term commencing in 1981, after serving in an *ad hoc* consultative capacity during 1980. The Secretary-General very much appreciates their willingness to continue to carry on this important international public service.

3. Mr. Toshio Shishido, who has served with the Committee since 1975, has indicated his desire to retire on the expiry of his term. In his place, the Secretary-General has asked, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, Mr. Matsukawa to serve on the Committee for a three-year term commencing in 1982.

4. The advice of the Investments Committee has been invaluable to the Secretary-General and his predecessors in carrying out their responsibilities for the

investment of the assets of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund. As the Secretary-General has stated to the Joint Staff Pension Board and the Advisory Committee, he draws in addition upon such specialized expertise as may be advisable, having in mind the investments of the Fund.

5. In order to provide for continuity in the membership of the Investments Committee, the terms of the members have been staggered. If the General Assembly confirms the proposed appointments, the United Nations Investments Committee would consist of the following members:

Mr. Aloysio de Andrade Faria, Mr. B. K. Nehr and Mrs. Stanislaw Raczkowski, whose terms of office will expire on 31 December 1982;

Mr. David Montagu, Mr. Yves Oltramare and Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe, whose terms of office expire on 31 December 1983;

Mr. Jean Guyot, Mr. George Johnston and Mr. Michiya Matsukawa, whose terms of office expire 31 December 1984.
