## PERSONNEL QUESTIONS

## Respect of the privileges and immunities of officials of the United Nations and the specialized agencies

Ethiopia: amendments to the draft resolution contained in document A/C.5/36/L.16

1. Insert the following new paragraph after the fourth preambular paragraph:

Recalling also the obligations of the staff in the conduct of their duties, to observe scrupulously the laws and regulations of Member States and, in particular, to refrain from all abuses of privilege,

- 2. Replace operative paragraph 1 by the following:
  - 1. Appeals to all Member States to respect the privileges and immunities accorded to officials of the United Nations and the specialized agencies by the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations of 13 February 1946 and by the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialized Agencies of 21 November 1947;
- 3. Add the following new operative paragraph 2:
  - 2. Requests the Secretary-General to ensure that the staff scrupulously observe the obligations incumbent upon them in accordance with the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the United Nations, the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Specialized Agencies and the relevant staff rules and regulations;
- 4. Renumber existing operative paragraph 2 as operative paragraph 3.
- 5. Replace existing operative paragraph 3 by the following operative paragraph 4:

4. Requests the Secretary-General to submit, on behalf of the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination, a report to the General Assembly, when he deems it necessary, on cases in which the Secretary-General has not been able to fully exercise his inherent right and duty in respect of the protection of staff members of the United Nations or of the specialized or related agencies.
