NOTE VERBALE DATED 20 JANUARY 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF ETHIOPIA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General and, with reference to Security Council resolution 1132 (1997) of 8 October 1997, has the honour to inform him that, at present, Ethiopia does not have any trade relations with Sierra Leone, including in the areas specifically mentioned in resolution 1132 (1997), and will not establish any such relations with that country in so far as the military junta is in power in Sierra Leone.

Furthermore, the Government of Ethiopia has taken the necessary measures to prevent entry into or transit through Ethiopia of members of the military junta in Sierra Leone and adult members of their families, in accordance with resolution 1132 (1997) of 8 October 1997.
