NOTE VERBALE DATED 15 JANUARY 1998 FROM THE PERMANENT
REPRESENTATIVE OF LUXEMBOURG TO THE UNITED NATIONS
ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Luxembourg to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General and has the honour to inform him of the measures that Luxembourg has taken with a view to implementing the provisions of paragraphs 5 and 6 of Security Council resolution 1132 (1997) of 8 October 1997 concerning Sierra Leone. These measures supplement those taken by the Council of the European Union on 8 December 1997.

Restrictions on entry or transit

The Office of Passports, Visas and Legislation of Luxembourg has been instructed to take appropriate measures to comply, on the basis of the list drawn up by the sanctions committee, with the restrictions contained in paragraph 5 of the resolution.

Provision of petroleum and petroleum products and arms and related matériel

The measures contained in paragraph 6 are the subject of a Luxembourg regulation that requires a permit for the export or transit of certain goods to Sierra Leone.
