CONSIDERATION OF REPORTS SUBMITTED BY STATES PARTIES
UNDER ARTICLE 19 OF THE CONVENTION

Initial reports of States parties due in 1998
Note by the Secretary-General

1. In accordance with article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman or Degrading Treatment or Punishment, the States parties shall submit to the Committee against Torture, through the Secretary-General of the United Nations, reports on the measures they have taken to give effect to their undertakings under the Convention, within one year after the entry into force of the Convention for the State party concerned. Thereafter the States parties shall submit supplementary reports every four years on any new measures taken and such other reports as the Committee may request.

2. Accordingly, initial reports under article 19, paragraph 1, of the Convention are due in 1998 from four States parties on the following dates:

Honduras	3 January 1998
Kenya	22 March 1998
Kyrgyzstan	4 October 1998
Saudi Arabia	21 October 1998

3. The reports received from the States parties listed above will be issued as addenda to this document.
